SCHOLARSHIPS

Jim Baker Memorial Scholarship-A \$500 scholarship to a graduate of Gravenstein School District who is currently a senior and planning on attending a four-year college or university in the Fall of 2006. Deadline NA

North Coast Builders Exchange- \$250- \$2,500 scholarships are available to children and grandchildren of the owners, partners or employees of NCBE members companies, OR to anyone pursuing a "Career in Construction" (including but not limited to, Architecture, Surveying, Engineering, Construction Management and the Building Trades). Deadline April 21.

Geyers Geothermal Association- Two \$500 scholarships are awarded to students who are most outstanding among applicants in their achievement including grades, activities and volunteer work. No formal application is required but an information sheet is available at the College and Career Center. Deadline April 14.

American Business Women's Association- Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to applicants (female and male applicants will be given equal consideration) who have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or better, have financial need and are currently attending a Sonoma County high school. Deadline April 3.

Mariassa Imrie Memorial Scholarship- \$750- \$1,000 scholarships to assist high school have experienced mental health issues and have sought help, are motivated to be successful and interested in continuing their education. Deadline April 20.

Redwood Empire ASHRAE Year 2005 Scholarship-At least two \$1,000 scholarships to graduates who have desire to pursue careers in field of environmental or mechanical engineering. Applicants must have history of community service and min. 3.0 GPA. Due May 2.

Society of Women Engineers Scholarship-Golden Gate Section-Scholarships open to female, graduating senior entering a bachelors degree program in engineering, computer science, physical science or mathematics. Due April 8.

Russian River Wine Road Scholarship-Two \$500 scholarships to graduates whose parents are employed by current winery or lodging members of the Russian River Wine Road. Due April 4.
